

**WESTCHESTER COUNTY PARKS
PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. As a parking permit holder, you are not entitled to a reserved space.
2. If demanded for parking permits exceeds the number of permit spaces that are available, names of patrons will be placed on a waiting list until a space becomes available.
3. Monthly permit holders must renew their permits by the 15th of the month in order to maintain their permit status. Months cannot be skipped..
4. Permits must be placed on lower left side above inspection sticker on windshield and be visible at all times. All expired permits must be removed from windshield.
5. Permit holder is responsible for transferring the permit between registered authorized vehicles. If you don't have your parking permit with you, the daily fee will apply.
6. Renewal should be acquired through the Westchester County Center Parking Division one month prior to the expiration date of the current permit. For information please call the parking division at (914) 995-7582.
7. Lost/stolen permits will only be replaced when a police report is presented. Call (914)-995-7582 and ask the Parking Division for information.
8. Payments received after the 15th of the month, are subject to a late fee of \$10. Vehicles should be locked at all times, with valuables not in view. Any security or safety issues should be directed to Westchester County Police at (914)-741-4400.
9. Park within one space as designated by pavement markings or signs. Violators may have privileges revoked at the discretion of the operator.
10. Observe all posted rules, regulations and signs of the facility and also the directions of the operator.
11. Violations of forgoing will result in fines and possible loss of permit privileges.
12. This agreement is a personal license to the holder of a permit to enable that person to park the designated vehicle at this facility at the holder's sole risk. Only a license is granted hereby and no bailment is created with respect to any vehicle, including its contents of the premises of the facility.
13. Westchester County Parks is not responsible for any loss or damage by fire, theft, collision, flooding or any other cause to any vehicle, or part thereof or the contents of any vehicle.
14. Permit refunds will only be given for the FULL unused month left on your permit. Refunds will not be given for partial months and all requests must be submitted in writing with permit attached and returned to the Parking Manager at the County Center 198 Central Ave. White Plains, NY 10606.
15. These parking rules and regulations are subject to change at the discretion of Westchester County Parks.
